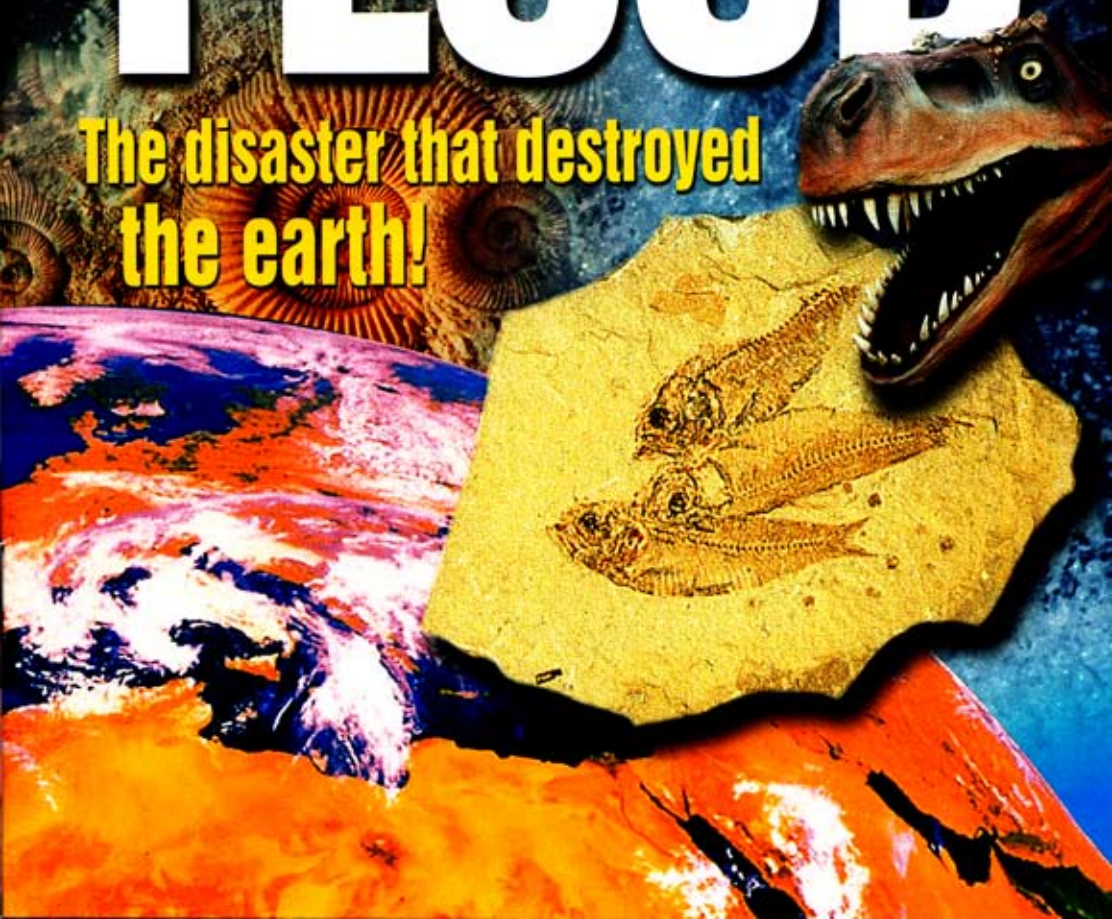




It's called conglomerate—lots of separate rocks, dumped together by fast-moving water and cemented together.



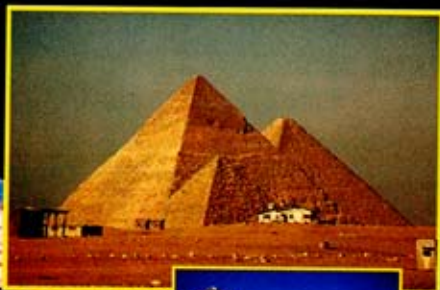
