*Hey, Dad, what is this?*

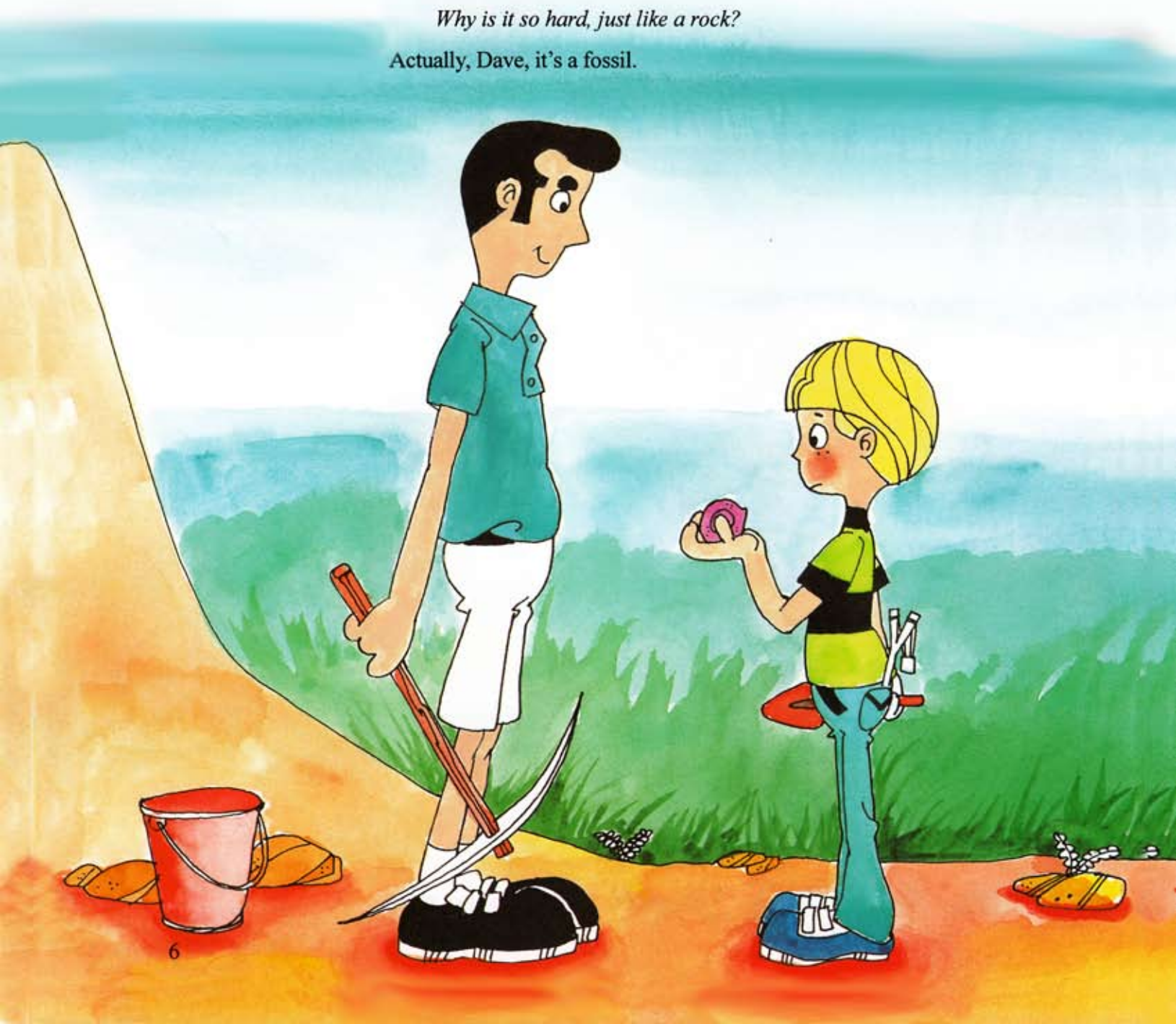
What does it look like, Dave?

*Why is it so hard, just like a rock?*

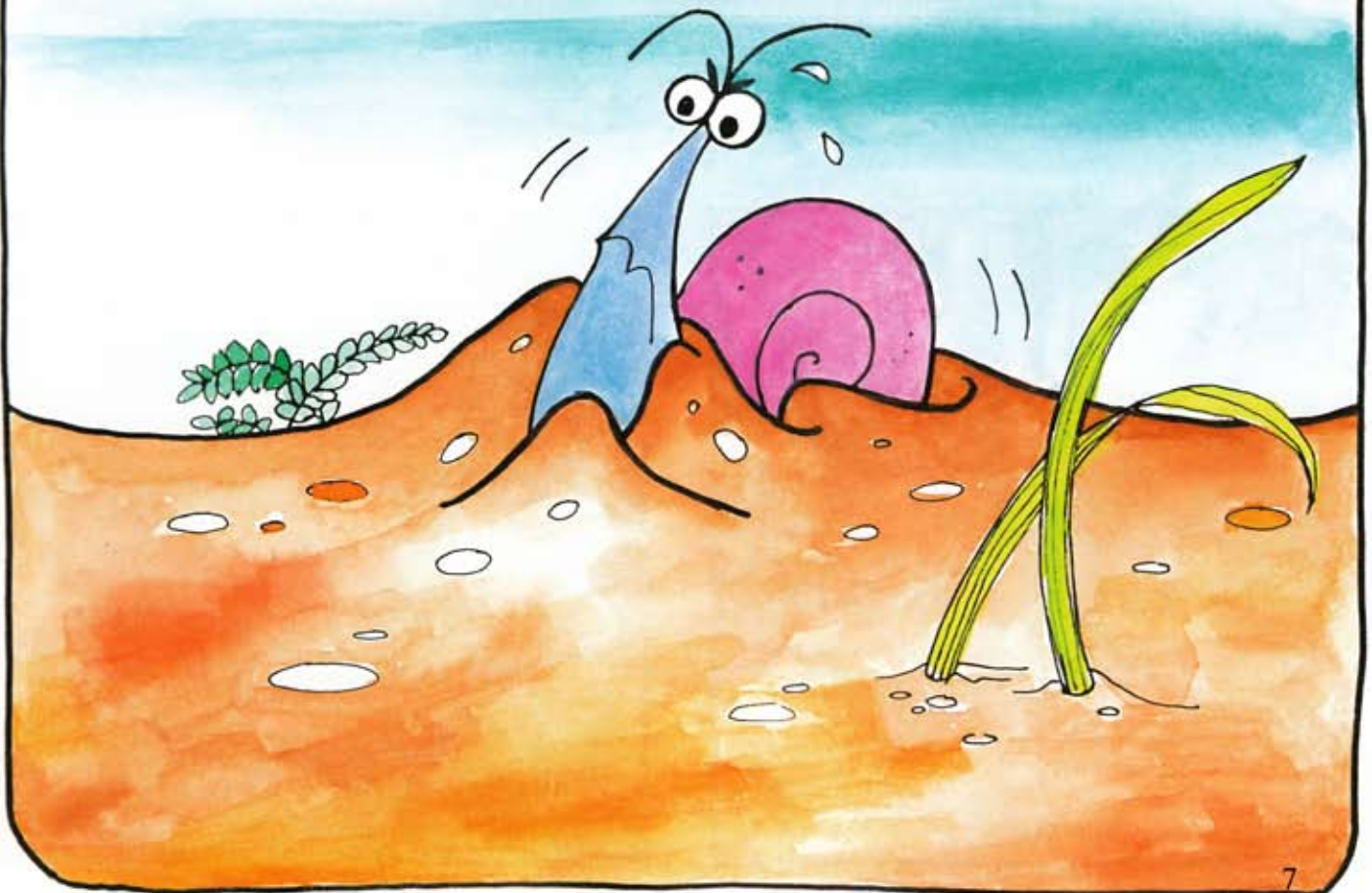
Actually, Dave, it's a fossil.
